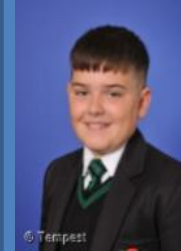
Micheál Kirwan - Sacred Heart PS, Rock

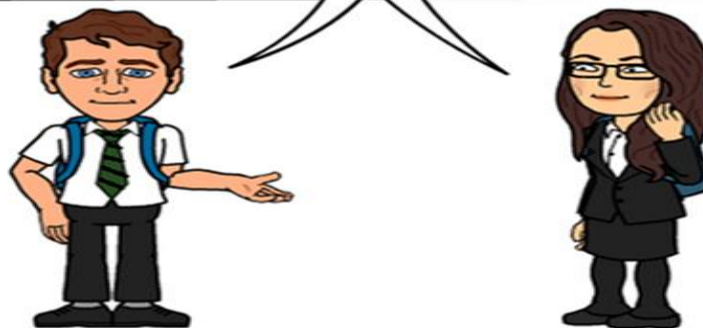
